I ask your special attention for the following:

- Exemption has been requested for all players on the Segbroek. Players who do not receive an exemption will be informed of this as soon as possible. Players who are not on the Segbroek have to arrange this exemption themselves.
- In connection with the introduction period at school, it is unfortunately not possible that players in the first form participate in all jubilee activities. But, it is the intention that every year an "Academy week" will be organized, so next year, the first graders will be there.

However, they also receive training from the guests on Monday and Tuesday, and they can come and watch outside the school hours on Wednesday afternoon, Thursday and Friday. They too all receive the Hoodie.

A Jubilee Magazine will be issued as part of the anniversary. This contains several interviews with Gareth Gilbert, Zeno Kieft and Phil Leck, articles about the physical development of the sport, the cooperation between the Academies and the combination school and top sport, portraits of (old) Academical players, beautiful atmospheric images and facts that give a picture of the past 10 years rugby and the Rugby Academies. A beautiful magazine with a high storage content. Each player (including the first graders) will receive one copy free of charge during DEGIRO Academy Week (they will receive theirs during training).
